Dear Alternate Election Judge:

You have volunteered and been appointed to perform the crucial task of helping to provide for the integrity of this Presidential Election.

Enclosed you will find the Secretary of State's "Handbook for Election Judges and Clerks." Please review this book carefully, as it will assist you in learning the law regarding the voting process.

Some of the most common concerns that you will need to monitor include:

- Be certain that early voting record is complete.
- Is the voter living at this address?
- If a person is NOT on the list, DO NOT ADD the voter to the rolls without first verifying with the County Registrar's office.
- ALWAYS check the effective date of the Voter's Registration Card.
- If no card is presented, see page eleven (11) of the enclosed handbook.
- If the Voter has moved to another county, then the Voter CANNOT vote in this county.
- If a Voter provides no evidence of identification, the Voter MUST vote a provisional ballot.
