## **INSTRUCTIONS (*INSTRUCCIONES*)**

An application to have the name of a candidate for the office of county chair placed on the ballot for any election may not be filed earlier than November 12, before the primary election. An application to have the name of a candidate for the office of precinct chair placed on the ballot may not be filed earlier than September 13. An application filed before that day is void. The filing deadline is December 12, of the general election year, at 6 p.m. Tex. Elec. Code Ann. § 172.023.

If the deadline for filing falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state or national holiday, the deadline is extended to the next regular business day.

The application shall be filed with the county chair or the secretary of the county executive committee, if there is one. Tex. Elec. Code Ann. § 172.022.

<sup>1</sup>All oaths, affidavits, or affirmations made within this State may be administered and a certificate of the fact given by a judge, clerk, or commissioner of any court of record, a notary public, a justice of the peace, city secretary, and the Secretary of State of Texas.
